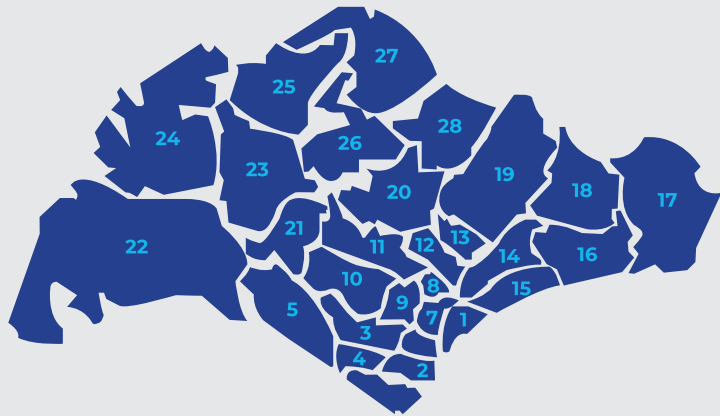


# The popular housing districts for expatriates in Singapore

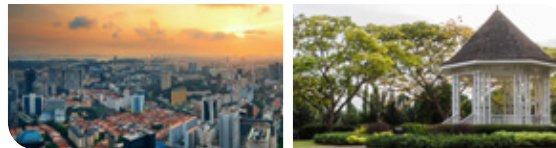

## District 1, 2, 3 and 4



- Considered central business districts with a variety of riverside restaurants, shops, nightlife and cultural buildings
- Offers some impressive housing options that come with luxurious amenities

## District 5 and 21



- Home to many international educational institutions (eg: Canadian International School and Dulwich College (Singapore))
- Offers a good mix of condos and landed homes within this foliage-rich area
- Comprises a variety of sub-urban shopping centres and an equestrian club

## District 9, 10 and 11



- Heartbeat of the city: Comprises Orchard Road where most luxurious high-rise condos and shops located
- Rents are high, but they're offset by the prime location, which also has many quiet, leafy pockets

## District 15 and 16



- Popular option for a quieter living experience with lots of open space
- A good mix of vibrant estates and apartments with excellent beach- or riverfront views
- Plenty of entertainment facilities such as Laguna Golf Course and East Coast Tennis Centre
